Scoring: No predefined number of races is scheduled, a practical number of Races suitable to time limits and weather conditions will be held. Appendix A (low point scoring) will be used, except that a boat's final score shall be the sum of all races with no throw-outs, this changes Rule A2; Starts will be in accordance with Appendix S (three minute start sequence); One race will constitute a regatta.
